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# MEMORANDUM OF ASSOCIATION of Friends of Brixton Market

(EXTRACT)

The Friends of Brixton Market's objects are

- (a) to promote the success of Brixton Market (the "Market"),
- (b) to conserve protect and develop the buildings and physical environment of the Market,
- (c) to promote the cultural diversity, accessibility and independence of the Market and its surrounding areas, and in particular to protect and support independent retailers serving the needs of the local communities,
- (d) to promote the environmental, social and economic development of the market and its surrounding areas,
- (e) to promote the success of traders' organisations associated with the Market from time to time where to do so would not conflict with FBM's other objects,
- (f) to promote equal opportunities for all people within the community, both in FBM's own affairs and in society generally, and
- (g) to do all such other things as are incidental or conducive to the attainment of any of the above objects.
